## THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (CONON BRIDGE) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, it will introduce a 20mph speed limit on the following roads in Conon Bridge over their entire length, unless otherwise stated below:

B9163- Conon Bridge – Alcaig – Shoreton – Balblair - Cromarty Road commencing at its junction with the Windhill – Ardullie Road(A862) and extending in a generally north east direction to a point 949 metres or thereby north east of its junction with the U3029 Wyvis Crescent; School Road (before it becomes B9163), commencing at its junction with A862 (Windhill – Ardullie Road) and extending in a generally south westerly direction for a distance of 84 metres or thereby to its termination; Old Leanaig Road, commencing at its junction with the B9163 Roundabout Conon Bridge and extending in a generally easterly direction to a point 65 metres or thereby east of its junction with the B9163 Roundabout Conon Bridge; Bridge View, Sku Dal Street; Barley Row; Cherry Drive; Thistle Road; Willow Court; Broom Court; Rowan Gardens; Braes of Conon; Cononbrae Close; Beinn View and Quarry Croft.
