## THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL PROPOSE TO CONSTRUCT 2 SETS OF SPEED CUSHIONS AND 2 RAISED TABLES ON U3547 HENRIETTA STREET AND 4 SETS OF SPEED CUSHIONS AND 1 RAISED TABLE ON C1041 WILLOWBANK, WICK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **The Highland Council**, in terms of the powers contained in section 36 AND 37 of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended, The Road Humps (Scotland) Regulations 1998, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf proposes to construct 2 sets of speed cushions and 2 raised table on U3547 Henrietta Street and 4 sets of speed cushions and 1 raised table on C1041 Willowbank as follows:

Description of the proposed speed cushions:-

- Speed cushions (3 no.), 124 metres or thereby Southeast of A99 George Street, U3547 Henrietta Street Junction, Wick
- Speed cushions (1 pair), 81 metres or thereby Northwest of U3443 Anderson Drive, U3547 Henrietta Street Junction, Wick
- Speed cushions (1 pair), 82 metres or thereby East of U3520 Girnigoe Street, C1041 Willowbank Junction, Wick
- Speed cushions (1 pair), 78 metres or thereby West of U3473 Bayview, C1041 Willowbank Junction, Wick
- Speed cushions (1 pair), 126 metres or thereby West of U3668 Lindsay Drive, C1041 Willowbank Junction, Wick
- Speed cushions (1 pair), 96 metres or thereby East of U3668 Lindsay Drive, C1041 Willowbank Junction, Wick

The speed cushions are 75mm in height (max), 1700 mm wide and 1900 mm in length with approach ramp gradient of 1:8 and slope gradient of 1:4.

Description of the proposed raised tables:-

- 128 metres or thereby Northwest of U3520 Girnigoe Street, U3547 Henrietta Street Junction, Wick
- 5 metres or thereby Southeast of U3520 Girnigoe Street, U3547 Henrietta Street Junction, Wick
- 62 metres or thereby East of U3647 Scalesburn, C1041 Willowbank Junction, Wick

The raised tables are 75mm in height (max), full road width and 4750 mm in length with approach ramp gradient of 1:15.
