

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (MUNLOCHY) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 20mph speed limit on the following roads in Munlochry over their entire length, unless stated otherwise below:

U2581 Littleburn Road (Starting from its junction with Artafallie – Munlochry Road (B9161) and extending north westwards for a total distance of 176 metres or thereby); U2726 Station Road, B9161 Artafallie - Munlochry Road (Starting from its junction with Cromarty - Fortrose - Tore - Muir of Ord - Moy Bridge Road (A832) and extending south westwards, then south eastwards to a point 110 metres of thereby south east of its junction with the Munlochry – Allangrange – Redfield Road (U2592) a total distance of 905 metres or thereby); U2592 – Munlochry – Allangrange – Redfield (Starting from its junction with Artafallie – Munlochry Road (B9161) and extending south westwards, a total distance of 80 metres or thereby).

In terms of Section 7 and Schedule 6 Part 3 paragraph 9 of the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020, the Council has decided not to make the draft Order and plans available for public inspection or publicise them other than by electronic means because to do otherwise may give rise to a significant risk of the transmission of coronavirus.
