THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL PROPOSE TO CONSTRUCT BUILD OUTS ON MAIN STREET, A836, CASTLETOWN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **The Highland Council**, in terms of the powers contained in section 39A of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended, The Roads (Traffic Calming) (Scotland) Regulations 1994, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf propose to construct build outs (uncontrolled pedestrian crossings) on Main Street, A836, Castletown as follows:

• 57 metres or thereby Southeast of the U2295 Finlayson's Lane, A836 Main Street Junction, Castletown.

The road narrowing is on both sides at the same position along the carriageway by constructing build out 1.6m wide flushed to the footpath at the west side of the carriageway and build out on the East 1.6m flushed to the footpath. The build out has an upstand to match existing kerb levels and is 7.1m in length reducing the carriageway width to 3.5m kerb to kerb. Road signs and road markings will be installed as per the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. The priority is given to vehicles travelling South-easterly.

• 27 metres or thereby Northwest of the B876 Wester Olrig, A836 Main Street Junction, Castletown.

The road narrowing is on both sides at the same position along the carriageway by constructing build out 0.6m wide flushed to the footpath at the west side of the carriageway and build out on the East 0.6m flushed to the footpath. The build out has an upstand to match existing kerb levels and is 5.1m in length reducing the carriageway width to 5.5m kerb to kerb. Road signs and road markings will be installed as per the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. No priority is required

In terms of Section 7 and Schedule 6 Part 3 paragraph 9 of the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020, the Council has decided not to make the schedule and plans available for public inspection or publicise them other than by electronic means because to do otherwise may give rise to a significant risk of the transmission of coronavirus.
