## TREE PRESERVATION ORDER NO. HC141, 2021 TARREL WOOD, PORTMAHOMACK, TAIN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in terms of Regulation 6 of the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulations, 2010 that The Highland Council confirmed The Highland Council Tree Preservation Order No. HC141, 2021 Tarrel Wood, Portmahomack, Tain on 18 May 2022.

The reason for confirming the Order is that these areas of trees are: This woodland was established under the Woodland Grant Scheme 3, approved by Forestry Commission Scotland in 2001, and now features in the Native Woodland Survey of Scotland (NWSS). The woodland provides a valuable amenity, both in terms of habitat creation and as a landscape feature, which will become more prominent as the trees continue to grow. An unauthorised track/hardstanding has been constructed which extends into the woodland. The Order will allow the Council to protect this valuable woodland feature and to encourage appropriate longer-term management.

The Order was confirmed without modifications.

This Order applies to: the trees (of whatever species) standing within the area marked W1 and shown within a continuous red line on the Map annexed to the Order.
