## TREE PRESERVATION ORDER NO. HC143, 2021 WOODSIDE FARM, CALDER, HALKIRK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in terms of Regulation 6 of the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulations, 2010 that The Highland Council confirmed The Highland Council Tree Preservation Order No. HC143, 2021 Woodside Farm, Calder, Halkirk on 23 May 2022.

The reason for confirming the Order: to protect an area of woodland, part of which is identified in the Ancient Woodland Inventory as Ancient Woodland of Semi-Natural Origin, meaning that it appears on the first edition Ordnance Survey maps dating back to the 1860's. Ancient woodlands and associated habitats are considered an important feature worthy of protection. A significant amount of unauthorised felling has taken place. The Order will allow the Council to protect this important woodland feature and to encourage appropriate longer-term management.

The Order was confirmed without modifications.

This Order applies to: the trees (of whatever species) standing within the area marked W1 and shown within a continuous red line on the Map annexed to the Order.
