Representations received regarding request for CAT of Loch St. Garages, Wick.

I have received the information about the Asset Transfer Request and have been online and looked at the application and the proposed site plan.

I have three concerns.

Firstly, I note that the application states the intention to hold social evenings. This has the capacity to create excess noise pollution in a residential area that includes elderly people, young families and people who have to be up for work in the morning. Therefore I believe there should be a time limit after which any social activity has to cease. Perhaps insist on all such activity having to finish by 10.00 pm.

Secondly, Parking is already an issue on Loch Street and if members of the Bowling club park in Loch Street, then that will increase problems for residents.

The submission does state that "The main access would still be from Northcote Street". I would request that, as a condition of approving the transfer, the Council state there must be no entrance to the Bowling Club from Loch Street.
