The ramp is 75 mm in height (max), full road width and 1125 mm in length with approach ramp gradient of 1:15. Ramp top and ties back into existing road level over length of 5500 mm

 South ramp is 17 metres or thereby Southwest of U2581 Littleburn Road, B9161 Millbank Road Junction, Munlochy

The ramp is 75 mm in height (max), full road width and 1125 mm in length with approach ramp gradient of 1:15. Ramp top and ties back into existing road level over length of 9200 mm

The raised section created will be 33.5 metres in length.
