

ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

**The Highland Council (U4403 Beechwood House Road) (Stopping Up) Order 2022**

The Highland Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 68(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having considered that the road specified in Part I of the Schedule to this order has become unnecessary and being satisfied that a suitable alternative road exists, hereby make the following order:-

1. This order may be cited as “The Highland Council (U4403 Beechwood House Road) (Stopping Up) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the.....2022.
2. The stopping up of the road in the Beechwood area of Inverness specified in Part I of the Schedule to this order is hereby ordered subject to the reservation of a means of passage for pedestrians and pedal cyclists specified in that part of the Schedule.
3. Where there is, immediately before the date on which the said road is stopped up under this order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across that length of road for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the said statutory undertakers shall after the commencement of this order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.

PART I  
ROAD TO BE STOPPED UP

That section of the U4403 Beechwood House Road (Old Perth Road, CUL-DE-SAC to Nos. 69 -79), Inverness, commencing at its junction with Old Perth Road (B9006) at a point 120 metres or thereby north west of the Inshes Roundabout (B8082) and extending in a north easterly direction for a distance 217 metres or thereby to its termination as shown in zebra hatching and marked "Road to be stopped up" on the plan annexed and signed as relative hereto..

There is a reservation of a means of passage for pedestrians and pedal cyclists as shown outlined in red and marked "cycle track" on the said plan.

PART II  
ALTERNATIVE ROAD

That section of road (consisting of a shared surface with 3.0metres wide contiguous footways on both sides for the latter 7.0metres) commencing at the north east corner of the U4403 Beechwood House Road (Old Perth Road, CUL-DE-SAC to Nos. 69 -79) and extending in a north easterly then easterly direction for a total distance of 64 metres or thereby to its junction with the U4704 Beechwood Park North road as shown in thin diagonal hatching and marked "Alternative Road".
