

Notice of Proposal to Designate Badenoch and Strathspey (Highland Council Ward 20) as a Short-Term Let Control Area (STLCA)

The Highland Council has prepared a Statement of Reasons to set out the proposal to establish a Short-Term Let Control Area (STLCA) in Badenoch and Strathspey (Highland Council Ward 20). The proposal is subject to public consultation between 31 January and 7 March 2022. The establishment of a STLCA across Badenoch and Strathspey will allow the Council to control the number of houses and flats used for "Secondary Letting" (where the owner is not resident) by requiring them to apply for Planning Approval.
