

# **Caol & Lochyside Flood Protection Scheme**

### Project Update –

### Kilmallie Rd flood wall

- Drainage and watermain installation continuing along Kilmallie Rd. Works to install both around 80% complete.
- Pumping station works underway. Temporary sheet piles have been installed now ready to accept large diameter manhole rings.
- This phase programmed for completion by March/April 2022 which will then allow flood wall construction to commence.


### **Caol foreshore flood embankment**

- Attenuation tank outfall works ongoing due to complete end of Jan.
- Embankment construction well underway with rock armour and fill ongoing. Approximately 200m has been constructed.
- Road works on Erracht Terrace progressing well. Will be finished end of January and will then move to Glenmallie Road.






# Kilmallie Rd – Traffic management phasing








Caol foreshore – Rock armour delivery route

Planned Works for next period up to Mid February/March

### Kilmallie Rd flood wall

- Continue with drainage and watermain installation.
- Continue with Pumping station construction.

#### **Caol foreshore flood embankment**

- Rock armour revetment works ongoing.
- Piling works along line of embankment.
- Drainage works along the toe of the embankment on the shore side.
- Drainage works will move along to Erracht Drive once finished on Glenmallie road.





## **Community Benefits**

- 90% of site personnel reside in the Highlands.
- 65% of site personnel live within 75-mile radius of the site.
- 50% of site personnel are locals (live within a 10-mile radius of the site).
- To date we have employed 2 local labourers, 1 ganger, 2 machine operators and a local cleaner all living within 2 miles of the site.
- Adverts in job centre for labourers and machine operators.
- Discussions with the local schools on talks, time capsules and training for secondary pupils.
- Donation of shinty equipment to Lochaber High School.
- An alternative design proposal for part of the works has generated benefits including reduced vehicle movements and a financial saving which is allocated to be spent on Community Benefits.
