Inverness Central

I will now declare the result of the election in the Inverness Central. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 8,647 and the number of ballot papers received was 3,362 giving a percentage turnout of $38.9 \%$. There were 76 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 822 .
