## Contest Name

Dingwall and Seaforth

I will now declare the result of the election in the Dingwall and Seaforth. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 10,385 and the number of ballot papers received was 4,700 giving a percentage turnout of $45.3 \%$. There were 60 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 929 .

The number of first preference votes for each of the candidates was:
