## THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (CORONAVIRUS) (NESS WALK – BUGHT ROAD, INVERNESS) (TEMPORARY ONE WAY TRAFFIC AND CYCLE CONTRAFLOW) ORDER 2020

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Coronavirus) (Ness Walk Bught Road) (Temporary One Way Traffic and Cycle Contraflow) Order 2020" and shall come into effect at 0600hrs on 26 June 2020 and will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3 Subject to Article 4 of this Order, while this Order is in force no person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in the schedule annexed and signed as relative to this Order in a northerly direction.
- 4 Pedal cycles are exempt from the restrictions specified in Article 3 of this Order.
