

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (DORNOCH SCHOOLS) (PART TIME 20MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will extend the part time 20mph speed limit on the following road in Dornoch as stated below:

A949 – Bonar Bridge -Clashmore and Evelix – Dornoch Road, from a point 180 metres or thereby west of its junction with Poles Road, Dornoch to a point 40 metres or thereby west of the centre line of the Dornoch Academy carpark access road for a total distance of 460 metres or thereby.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the relevant plans, the Authority's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order along with The Highland Council (Evelix Road, Dornoch) (Part Time 20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2005 which will be revoked in full and The Highland Council (Dornoch, Various Roads) (30 and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2016 which will be revoked in part if the proposed order comes into force can be inspected at the Dornoch Service Point, Carnegie Library, 8 High Street, Dornoch, IV25 3SH during normal opening hours from (14th July to 12th August 2022).
