ORDER TO EXEMPT LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (BLACK ISLE SHOW) ORDER 2022

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 (1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Black Isle Show) Order 2022", and shall come into operation at 06:00hrs on Wednesday 3rd August 2022 until 12:00hrs on Friday 5th August 2022 unless revoked earlier.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The effect of the Order is to exempt land at the Mannsfield Showground, Muir of Ord shown delineated in black on the plan annexed and signed as relative to this Order, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act. Rights of way are not affected by this Order.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

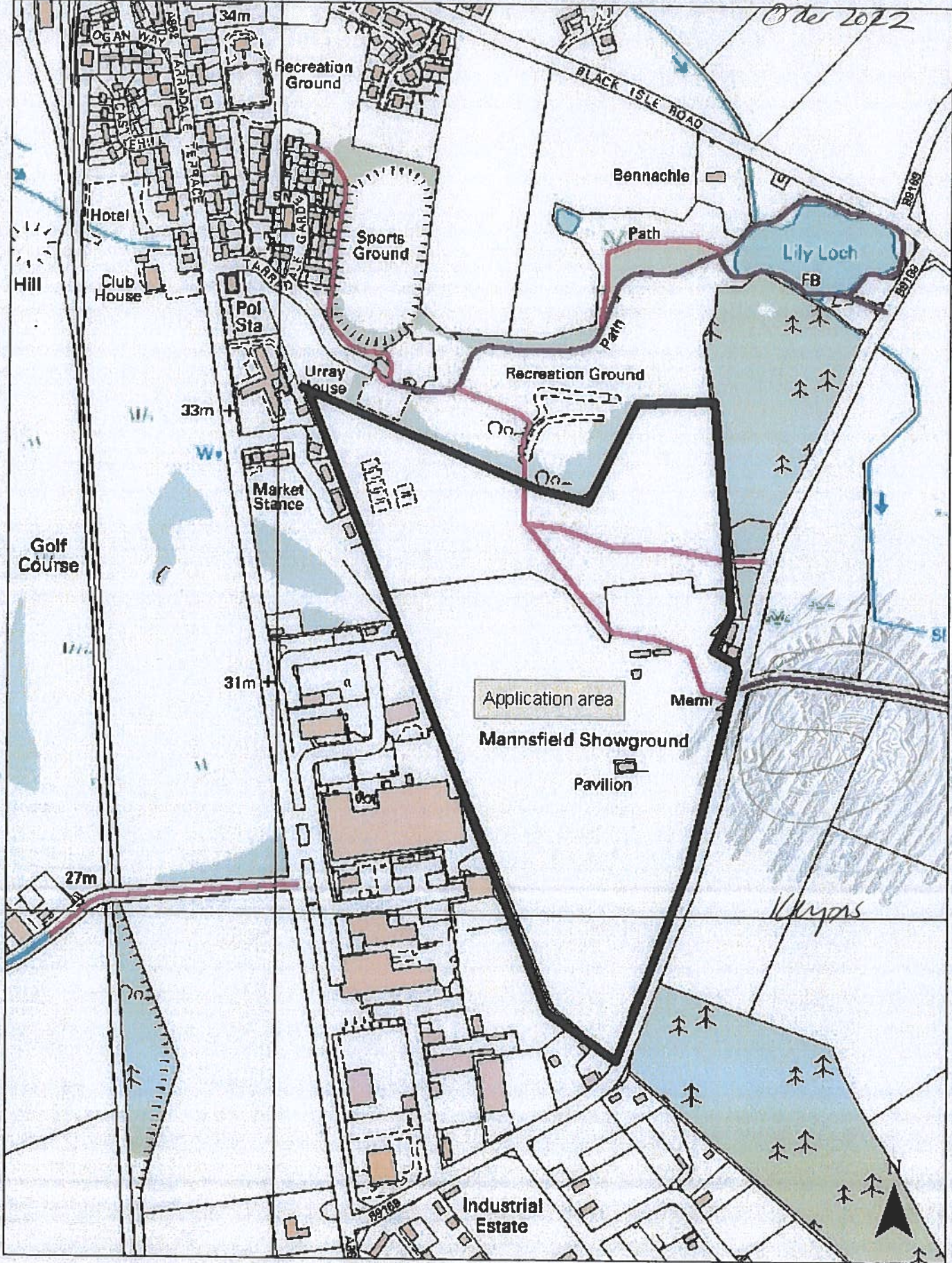
