

Notice is hereby given that The Highland Council has made THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (PLOCKTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2022

in terms of 14(1)(b) of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** entitled as above. The Order comes into force on 8th August 2022 and will remain in effect for a maximum of 18 months.

The reason for making the Order is that the Council, as Roads authority is satisfied in terms of s14(1)(b) of that Act that traffic on the road should be restricted due to the likelihood of danger to the public.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily

- (i) prohibit waiting at any time on sections of the following lengths of road: Innes Street, Harbour Street and Cooper Street and
- (ii) prohibit waiting between 8am and 4pm on Monday to Friday every week on a section of Innes Street as detailed in the Temporary Traffic Regulation Order.

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (PLOCKTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2022

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 being satisfied in terms of section 14(1)(b) of that Act that traffic on the road or roads referred to in this Order should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as 'The Highland Council (Plockton) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2022' and shall come into effect at 00:01 hrs on 8th Aug 2022 and remain in effect for a maximum period of 18 months.
- 2. The maps annexed and signed as relative to this Order and listed in the schedule annexed and signed as relative to this Order, which maps ("the Maps") depict the prohibitions imposed or designated by this Order and, in conjunction with the key depicted on each map, identify the type of each particular prohibition and certain of its governing provisions are hereby incorporated into this Order.
- 3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them: -

"parking enforcement officer" has the same meaning as "parking attendant" in section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description, and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads, whether or not by mechanical power;

"park" and "wait" refer to the stopping of a vehicle and it remaining at rest for some time whether or not the driver is still in the vehicle:

- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 5. While this Order is in force, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a parking enforcement officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or park at any time on any length of road which is identified on the Maps as being a length of road upon which a "No Waiting at Any Time" restriction applies
- 6. While this Order is in force, no person shall except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a parking enforcement officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or park at any time between the hours of 08:00hrs and 16:00hrs on any day of the week except Saturday and Sunday on any length of road which is identified on the Maps as being a length of road upon which a "No Waiting Mon Fri 8am 4pm" restriction applies.
- 7. No prohibition or restriction imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle being used in an emergency for ambulance, coastguard, fire brigade or police purposes.
