NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **The Highland Council**, in terms of the powers contained in section 36, 37 AND 39A of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended, The Road Humps (Scotland) Regulations 1998, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf proposes to construct 2 sets of speed cushions on C1143 Heathfield Road, 2 sets of speed cushions on A939 Castle Road East, 1 set of speed cushions and 1 sinusoidal road hump on C1143 South Street and 4 sets of speed cushions on B9102 Cromdale Station Road, Grantown on Spey as follows:

Description of the proposed speed cushions on Heathfield Road:-

• First pair of speed cushions is 120 metres or thereby South of B9102, C1143 Heathfield Road Junction, Grantown on Spey

The speed cushions are 75mm in height (max), 1800 mm wide and 1900 mm in length.

• Second pair of speed cushions is 257 metres or thereby South of B9102, C1143 Heathfield Road Junction, Grantown on Spey

The speed cushions are 75mm in height (max), 1700 mm wide and 1900 mm in length.

Description of the proposed speed cushions on Castle Road East:-

- First pair of speed cushions is 33 metres or thereby South of B9102, A939 Castle Road East Junction, Grantown on Spey
- Second pair of speed cushions is 120 metres or thereby South of B9102, A939 Castle Road East Junction, Grantown on Spey

The speed cushions are 75mm in height (max), 1800 mm wide and 1900 mm in length.

Description of the proposed speed cushions South Street:-

• The pair of speed cushions is 154 metres or thereby Northeast of U2791 Forest Road, C1143 South Street Junction, Grantown On Spey

The speed cushions are 75mm in height (max), 1700 mm wide and 1900 mm in length.

Description of the proposed sinusoidal road hump on South Street:-

• The sinusoidal road hump is 25 metres or thereby Northeast of U2791 Forest Road, C1143 South Street Junction, Grantown On Spey

The sinusoidal road hump is 75mm in height (max), width is 100mm offset from each kerb and 3696 mm in length.

Description of the proposed speed cushions Cromdale Station Road:-

- First pair of speed cushions is 32 metres or thereby Southeast of A939 Castle Road East, B9102 Junction, Grantown on Spey
- Second pair of speed cushions is 109 metres or thereby Southeast of A939 Castle Road East, B9102 Junction, Grantown on Spey

The speed cushions are 75mm in height (max), 1800 mm wide and 1900 mm in length.

- Third pair of speed cushions is 76 metres or thereby Southeast of C1143 Heathfield Road, B9102 Junction, Grantown on Spey
- Fourth pair of speed cushions is 221 metres or thereby Southeast of C1143 Heathfield Road, Junction, Grantown on Spey

The speed cushions are 75mm in height (max), 1600 mm wide and 1900 mm in length.
