

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL**  
**PROPOSE TO CONSTRUCT A RAISED TABLE UNCONTROLLED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING**  
**ON U1058 CAULFIELD ROAD NORTH, INVERNESS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **The Highland Council**, in terms of the powers contained in section 36 and 37 of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended, The Road Humps (Scotland) Regulations 1998, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf proposes to replace the existing speed cushions and construct 1 raised table on U1058 Caulfield Road North as follows:

Description of the proposed raised table road hump:-

- Raised table (1 no.), 225 metres north of the U1058 Caulfield Road North/ U1058 Castle Hill Road junction.

The raised table is 75mm in height (max) across the carriageway kerb to kerb, this consists of a raised section (75mm in height) 3000 mm wide on top with two tapered ramps located on each side 1500 mm in width.
