

## **Caol & Lochyside Flood Protection Scheme**



Community Liaison Meeting 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2022





#### Project Update -

#### Kilmallie Rd flood wall

- Silt curtain has been installed in the river Lochy and is working as expected. Regularly inspected and monitored.
- Flood Wall concrete works ongoing 12no base and wall sections now poured.
- Rock armour works on river Lochy around 50% complete.
- Piling works underway again 450m remains to complete piling along riverside.

#### **Caol foreshore flood embankment**

- Last 2 gullies remain on Erracht Drive. Completed this week.
- Kerbing works are 90% complete along Caol foreshore. Footpath is regulated ready for tar.
- Tactile paving works on foreshore side of road are installed.
- Scottish water Diversion works SW04, SW08 & 09 are ongoing. Works are 80% complete, watermain needs to be tested.
- 20% of the landscaping works have been completed between the footpaths.







Planned Works for next period up to end of September

#### Kilmallie Rd flood wall

- Rock armour works continuing on river Lochy embankment.
- Steel fixing for flood wall ongoing.
- Concrete pours to flood wall as far as wet well.
- Piling works ongoing.
- Gully installation on Kilmallie road.

#### Caol foreshore flood embankment

- Drainage works on Erracht drive will be completed.
- Ramp 4 gabion basket installation will be ongoing.
- SW diversion SW04 and foul rising main SW08 & 09 will be finished.
- Landscaping works ongoing.
- Footpath to be surfaced.





### **Community Benefits**

- 90% of site personnel reside in the Highlands.
- 65% of site personnel live within 75-mile radius of the site.
- 50% of site personnel are locals (live within a 10-mile radius of the site).
- To date we have employed 2 local labourers, 1 ganger, 2 machine operators and 3 local cleaners all living within 2 miles of the site.
- Adverts in job centre for labourers and machine operators.
- Discussions with the local schools on talks, time capsules and training for secondary pupils.
- Donation of shinty equipment to Lochaber High School.
- An alternative design proposal for part of the works has generated benefits including reduced vehicle movements and a financial saving which is allocated to be spent on Community Benefits.
