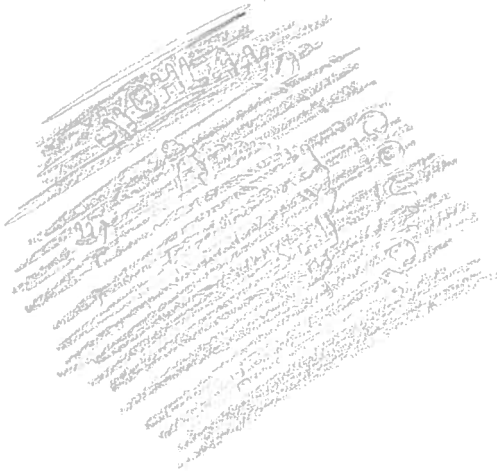
ORDER TO EXEMPT LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (STRATHPUFFER 2023) ORDER 2022

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 (1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Strathpuffer 2023) Order 2022", and shall come into operation at 12:00hrs on Friday 13 January 2023 until 12:00hrs on Sunday 15 January 2023 unless revoked earlier.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The effect of the Order is to exempt land, namely land within Contin Forest, Contin shown marked by a blue line on the plan annexed and signed as relative to this Order, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act. Rights of way are not affected by this Order.

# Strathpuffer Route Map

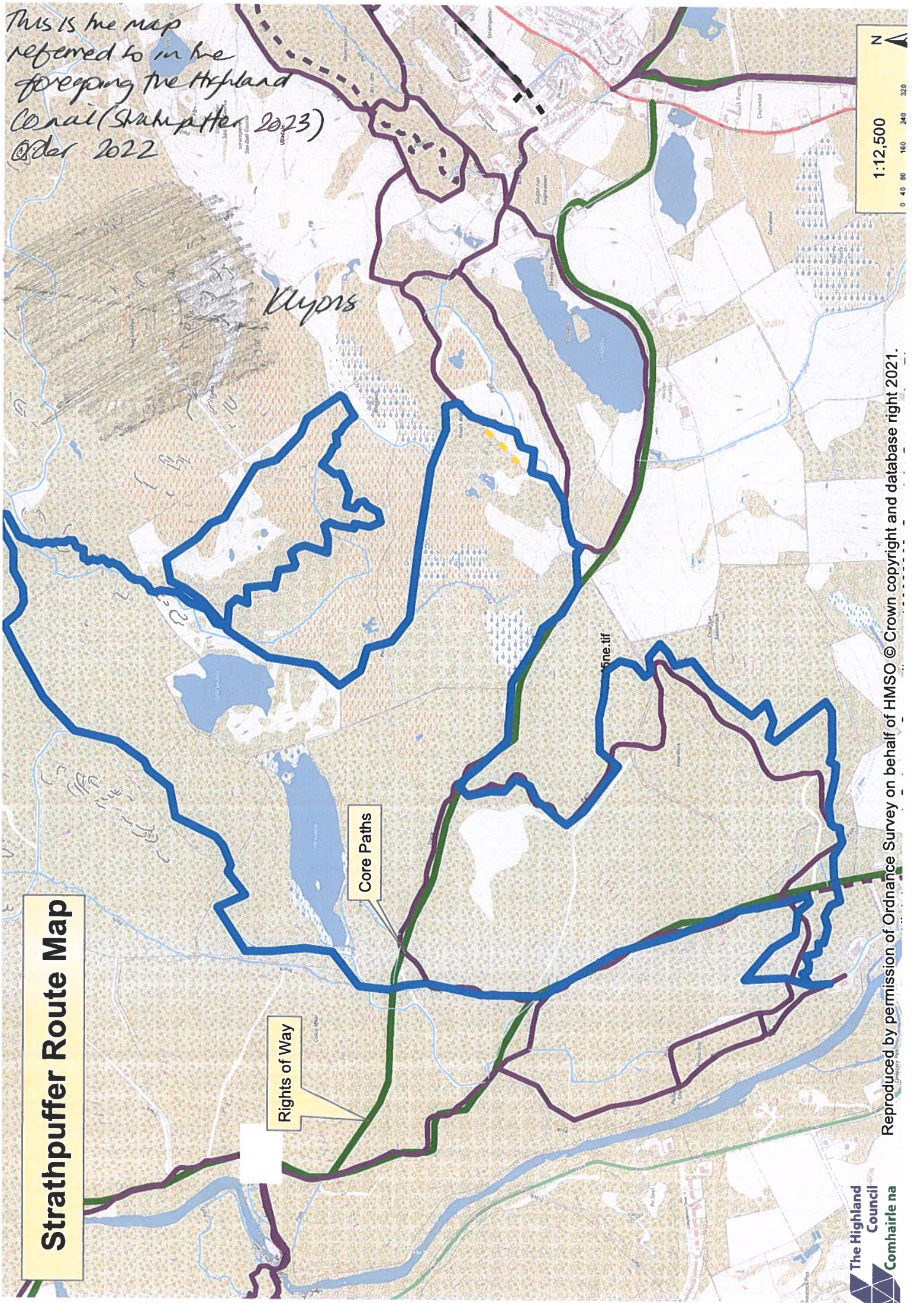
