

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (A851 KILBEG, SKYE) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT  
EXTENSION) ORDER 2023**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 40mph speed limit on the following length of road in Kilbeg, Skye:

**Route A851**

Commencing at the A851/U5723 Rathad Mhicguaire Junction, Kilbeg, Skye and extending west towards Armadale for a distance of 316 metres or thereby.
