

HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL (BEAULY -
30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER, 1982

The Highland Regional Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them under Section 74 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the "Highland Regional Council (Beauly - 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1982". The Order comes into operation on 6th July, 1982.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be subject to a Speed Limit of 30 m.p.h.
4. All provisions contained in any Orders or others in so far as the same are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent and meaning hereof shall cease to have effect and are hereby revoked.
