

## **THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (GRANTOWN ON SPEY) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council on the 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2023 made, in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the above Order which will come into operation on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

The Order was previously advertised by Notice in The Strathspey and Badenoch Herald on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> August 2022 and the effect of the Order is as described in that Notice.
