SPEED CUSHION SCHEME ON B8006 KILMALLIE ROAD, CAOL, FORT
WILLIAM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **The Highland Council**, in terms of the powers contained in section 36 and 37 of the **Roads (Scotland) Act 1984** as amended and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf **propose to remove the existing build out (nearest house number 172) and install four new sets of speed cushions and replace three existing sets with new speed cushions of a larger dimension as part of an overall speed cushion scheme** on the B8006 Kilmallie Road, Caol, Fort William to support the 20mph speed limit as follows:

Description of the proposed speed cushions: -

- First pair located 64 metres or thereby Northeast of U1662 Blar Mhor Road, B8006 Kilmallie Road Junction, Caol
- Second pair located 20 metres or thereby Northeast of U1662 Blar Mhor Road, B8006 Kilmallie Road Junction, Caol
- Third pair located 46 metres or thereby Southwest of U1662 Blar Mhor Road, B8006 Kilmallie Road Junction, Caol
- Fourth pair located 179 metres or thereby Southwest of U1662 Blar Mhor Road, B8006 Kilmallie Road Junction, Caol
- Fifth pair located 53 metres or thereby North of U1166 Glenkingie Terrace, B8006 Kilmallie Road Junction, Caol
- Sixth pair located 89 metres or thereby South of U1166 Glenkingie Terrace, B8006 Kilmallie Road Junction, Caol
- Seventh pair located 22 metres or thereby Northwest of U1234 Broom Drive, B8006 Kilmallie Road Junction, Caol

The speed cushions are 75mm in height (max), 1800 mm wide and 1900 mm in length with approach ramp gradient of 1:8 and slope gradient of 1:4.
