Did you know that 179 of respondents have never voted before, this was mainly down to the fact that they were too young to vote.

## Have you ever voted in any local or national elections and how would you rate your voting experience?

Whereas 28 of respondents had voted before and had rated their experience at an average of 6 out of 10.

## Would you consider voting at future elections and what changes would you like to see to encourage you to vote again?

Did you know that 194 of respondents would consider voting in future elections, most experienced voters would like to see more information and education about voting in and out of schools.

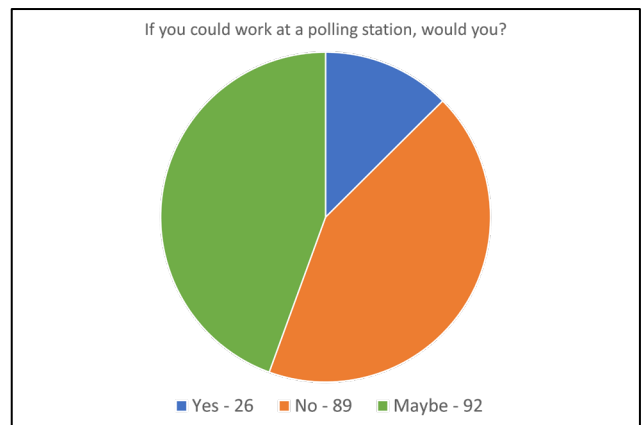
## Would you consider voting at future elections and what would encourage you to vote?

For first time voters, they would like to see more education and information readily available, more awareness being given that an election taking place, seeing how their vote makes a difference, knowledge on registering to vote and equality.

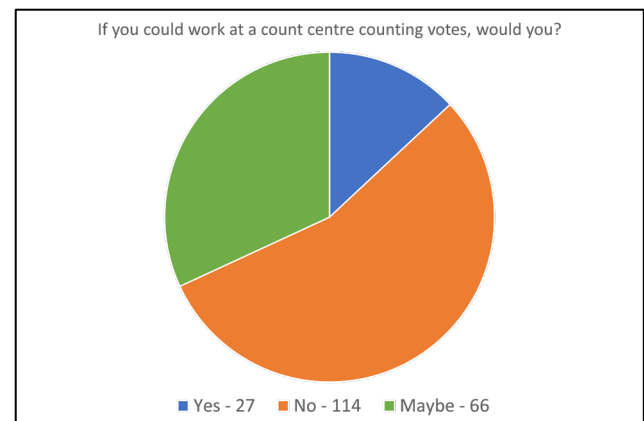
## What would encourage you to vote at elections?

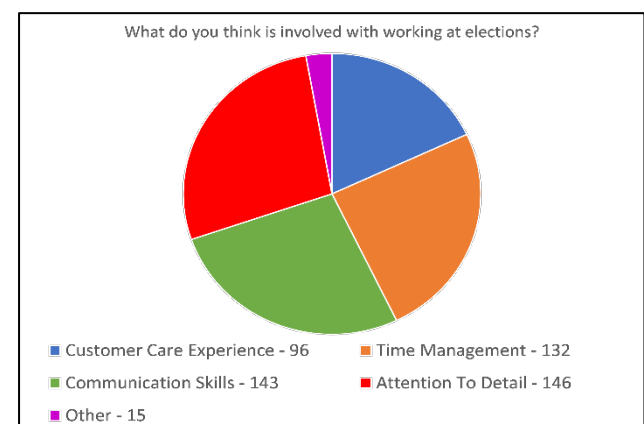
