**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (INVERGORDON AND SALTBURN) (SPEED LIMITS)**  
**ORDER 2001**

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Invergordon and Saltburn) (Speed Limits) Order, 2001 and shall come into operation on 14 August 2001.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 30mph over the lengths of road specified in Schedule One hereto.
4. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 40mph over the lengths of road specified in Schedule Two hereto.
5. All provisions contained in any Orders, enactments or others insofar as the same are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent and meaning hereof shall cease to have effect, and in particular the Highland Regional Council (Shore Road and High Street, Invergordon) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 1980 is hereby revoked.

**SCHEDULE ONE**

**30 MPH SPEED LIMIT - LENGTHS OF ROAD AFFECTED**

**Route B817 , Alness - Invergordon - Kildary Road**

From a point 171 metres or thereby northwest of the centreline of High Street, Invergordon southeastwards, then northeastwards to a point 116 metres or thereby northeast of the centreline of High Street, Invergordon a distance of 1562metres or thereby.

**Route C16 , Invergordon - Tomich Road**

From its junction with Castle Road, Invergordon northeastwards then northwestwards to a point 40 metres or thereby northwest of the centreline of the U8/64 Castle Avenue Industrial Estate Distributor Road, Invergordon a distance of 971 metres or thereby .

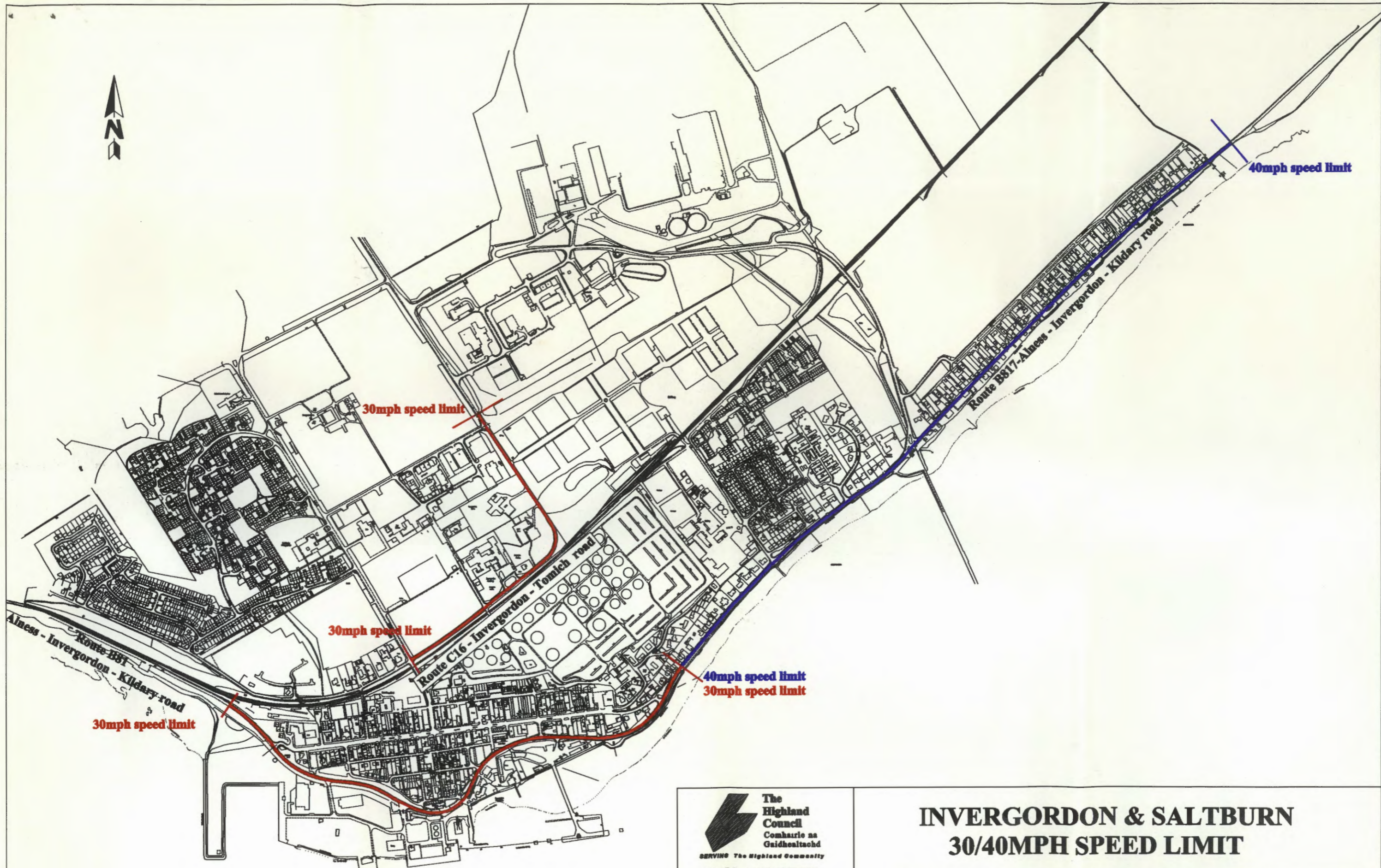
## **SCHEDULE TWO**

### **40 MPH SPEED LIMIT - LENGTHS OF ROAD AFFECTED**

#### **Route B817, Alness – Invergordon –Kildary Road**

From a point 116 metres or thereby northeast of the centreline of High Street, Invergordon northeastwards to a point 86 metres or thereby northeast of the northeast gable of the property known as No 84 Saltburn a distance of 2171 metres or thereby.
