THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (GLEN NEVIS ROAD, FORT WILLIAM)
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1996

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Glen Nevis Road, Fort William) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order, 1996 and shall come into operation on 26 July 1996.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 30 mph over the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

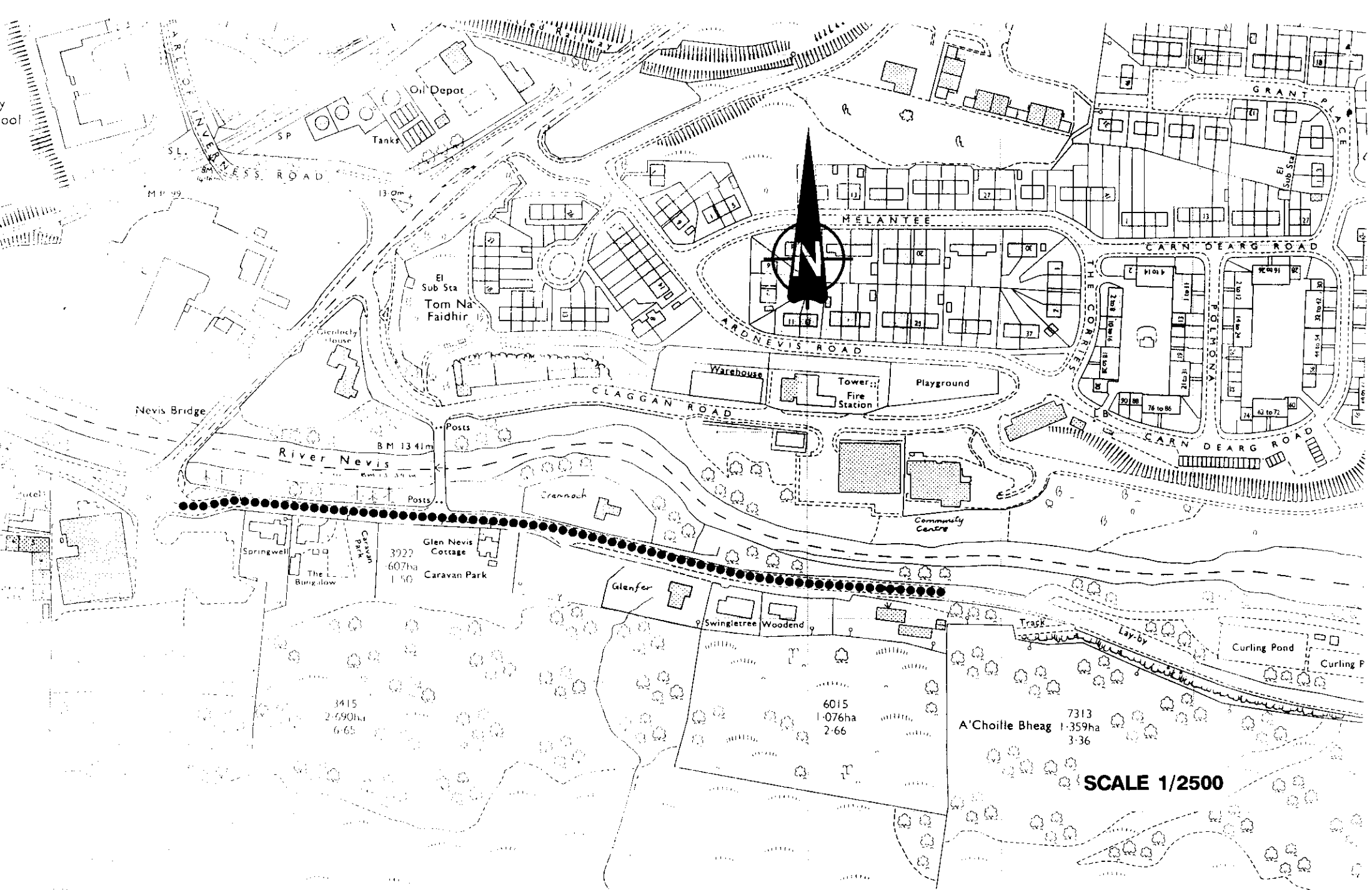

Length of Road Referred to

Route C55 - Glen Nevis Road, Fort William from its junction with the route A82 Inverness- Fort William Trunk Road eastwards to a point 60 metres or thereby east of the eastern boundary fenceline of the property known as Woodend.
