

## **THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (A836 BONAR BRIDGE TO ARDGAY) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION AND 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 30mph speed limit on the A836 commencing 141m or thereby to the west of its junction with the A949 Bonar – Clashmore – Dornoch Road and travelling in a westerly direction for a distance of 270m or thereby.

The Order will also introduce a 50mph speed limit on the A836 commencing 206m or thereby to the south of its junction with the C1136 Ardgay – Brae Road and Link Road in Ardgay and travelling in a north easterly direction for a total distance of 955m or thereby.
