3.1	Item 3.4 - JG queried whether a pothole on Glenkingie Street is to be repaired. GK to investigate remedial action for when the next surfacing is planned.	GK

4.1	Overview of project progress presented by SM. This included an update on traffic management, resurfacing works, footway works on the embankment at shinty club and flood wall construction. The presentation will be available on THC website (detailed below) once final minutes are issued	Note

4.2	JG queried whether there is further work to be done to the flood wall gate posts as at present they are plain. GK and GS say there are no plans to alter they look but the project team will investigate the options for anti-coating on the pillars.	Note
4.3	JG stated that one of plinths and all the benches have been removed and queried why. GK advised that only two of the plinths are to remain and the benches have been returned the manufacturer.	Note
4.4	JG queried the duration planned for the 3-way traffic lights. GK advised that the aspiration is to return to one set of traffic lights week commencing 10 th July after the SSE cable has been tied in. CS added that there was never a consultation regarding 2 sets of traffic lights being operational at one time and this is causing delays. GK advised that the signs to give prior warning to road users are still in place and the diversion is available.	Note
4.5	CS highlighted that there isn't a definite date for the meter install for the community cupboard and is going to raise a complaint with SSE. GK to liaise with THC energy team to see if they can give any assistance. CS is going to remove the filing cabinets to allow the fridge and freezer to be stored. Post meeting note: CS was advised that the meter would be installed on 21/08/23.	Note

GK advised he thinks the works being carried out by Bear Transport Scotland are offline (not on the carriageway).
