THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (TEMPORARY 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council, being satisfied that traffic on certain roads should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public, has made the above-named order in terms of Section 14(1)(b) of the Roads Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to introduce a 20mph speed limit on roads in 125 settlements across the Highland Council area, including Inverness and other towns and villages throughout Highland. Traffic signs will indicate where the speed limit applies.

The Order, which has a maximum duration of 18 months, will come into operation on Monday 31st July 2023. While the Order is in operation the 20mph speed limit will apply 24 hours a day on the roads affected.
