

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (A838 TONGUE) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION ) ORDER  
2023**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following section of road:

**Route – A0838 – LAIRG – TONGUE ROAD.** Commencing at a point 30 metres or thereby north of St Andrews Glebe junction and extending generally northwards for 495 metres or thereby.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the relevant plan and the Authority's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order, along with THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (TONGUE) (20 MPH. 30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2008 which will be revoked in part if the proposed order comes into force can be inspected at the Bettyhill Service Point, Naver-Teleservice Centre, Bettyhill, KW14 7SS from 10<sup>th</sup> August to 11<sup>th</sup> September, during opening hours, Monday to Friday 09:00 – 12:30.
