

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (A838 TONGUE) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION)  
ORDER 2023**

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The Highland Council (A838 Tongue) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2023” and shall come into effect on .....
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. All provisions contained in any Order enactment or others insofar as the same are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent and meaning hereof shall cease to have effect and are hereby revoked.

In particular, the provisions of the: The Highland Council (Tongue) (20 mph 30 mph and 40 mph Speed Limits) Order 2008 are revoked in so far as they relate to lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

4. No person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule annexed and signed as relative to this Order at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour.

## **SCHEDULE**

**Route – A0838 – LAIRG – TONGUE ROAD.**

Commencing at a point 30 metres or thereby north of St Andrews Glebe junction and extending generally northwards for a distance of 495 metres or thereby.
