Notice is hereby given that The Highland Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46,47 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1991 Act") and of all other enabling powers proposes to make an Order entitled as above the general effect of which is as described in the Schedule below.

#### Schedule

This Order Variation will introduce waiting and loading restrictions and on-street pay and display parking and affects the roads at:

- C1126 Glenmore Road between its junction with Rothiemurchus Lodge Access Road eastwards to the Snow gates for Cairngorm Mountain and a section of road at the entrance to the Coire Cas Ski Lift Car Park
- The access Road leading to Glenmore Lodge from its junction with the C1126 eastwards to its junction with the Glenmore Lodge.

#### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

The Highland Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation) Variation Seven Glenmore Order 2023

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46,47 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") as amended and of the Road Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby proposes the following Order.

- This Order shall come into operation on the xx xxx 2023 and may be cited as "The Highland Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation) Variation Seven Glenmore 2023"
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment provided that where a prohibition or restriction which is imposed, varied or revoked by this Order is in conflict with a prohibition or restriction imposed by a previous Order, then the provision of this Order shall prevail.
- 4. If a court, Transport Scotland or the Parking and Bus Lane Tribunal Service for Scotland, declares any part of this Order to be invalid or un-enforceable, such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of this Order.

5. The Highland Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation)
Order 2016 as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order") is hereby varied as follows: (i) the plans specified in Schedule 1 to this Order are inserted therefor and hereby added and incorporated into schedule 1 to the Principal Order, (ii) the tariffs specified in Schedule 2 to this Order are inserted therefore and hereby added and incorporated in schedule 4 table 4.1 to the Principal Order.

This Order and the 2 schedules annexed hereto are sealed with the Common Seal of The Highland Council and signed for them and on their behalf at Dingwall on xx xxx 2023 by Shona Ann Pottinger, Solicitor and Proper Officer.

Highland Council parking enforcement officers issue Penalty Charge Notices in respect of contraventions of this Order.




# Glenmore 2023 Overview




