THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (FOUNDRY WAY INVERNESS) (ONE WAY) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and 2(2), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and of all the other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby propose to make the following order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Foundry Way, Inverness) (One Way) Traffic Regulation Order 2024" and shall come into operation on 19th February 2025.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. All provisions contained in any order, enactment or others in so far as the same repeat or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and true intent and meaning hereof shall cease to have effect and are hereby revoked.
- 4. Subject to Article 5 of this Order, no person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule 1 annexed and signed as relative hereto other than in the direction specified opposite in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
- 5. Pedal cycles are exempt from the restrictions detailed in Article 4 of this Order.
