

ROSE STREET MULTI-STOREY CAR PARK – INVERNESS
STANDARD CONTRACT CAR PARK CARD – CONDITIONS OF USE

(1) **USE OF CARD**

The parking card must be used to enter and exit the multi-storey car park at all times.

(2) **ELIGIBLE PARKING BAYS**

Parking bays are not individually allocated to Standard Contract Parking customers. This parking card enables you to park in any available bay in the above car park from Level 3 to Level 10 inclusive, apart from:

- Parent & Child spaces
- Disabled Bays (unless you are in possession of a valid disabled parking badge)

(3) **DIRECT DEBIT PAYMENT**

Once a Direct Debit has been set up and approved, the lease will subsist on a monthly basis at a rental of £63.00 per month per card (£52.50 plus £10.50 VAT) or other such sum as the Council may determine.

Payments will be taken for complete months only on the last day of each month.

(4) **REPLACEMENT OF LOST OR DAMAGED PARKING CARDS**

- a) A lost or damaged parking **card will be replaced at a cost of £10.00** or other such sum as the Council may determine.
- b) If your card is damaged through wear and tear please present your card to the Car Park Office to determine whether charges should apply.
- c) All damaged cards must be returned to the Car Park Office.
- d) Parking cards reported lost will be rendered invalid and cannot be returned to use if subsequently found.

(5) **TERMINATION OF LEASE**

- a) The lease can only be terminated by **one month's advance notice in writing** from either side.
- b) The parking card remains at all times the property of Highland Council. When a lease is terminated, the parking card must be returned to Highland Council immediately following the last date of paid use.
- c) The lease will be deemed terminated without further notice in the event that rental remains due and unpaid.

(6) **COPYING OF PARKING CARDS**

Copying of parking cards or attempted use of a duplicate permit is an offence and will result in immediate cancellation of the lease.

(7) **LIABILITY FOR PARKED VEHICLES**

The lease is offered in terms of and subject to the provisions of THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (DECRIMINALISED PARKING ENFORCEMENT AND CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2016 as amended on the understanding that the Council accepts no responsibility and that no claim will lie against the Council for damage or theft from your vehicle while it is in the aforementioned car park.

This data will be maintained in accordance with the Act and will not be passed on or sold to any other organisation without your prior approval unless this is a legal requirement.
