

Settlement Assessment

Quantity

Similar to other rural locations in Highland there is significant opportunity to access open space in close proximity to the settlement however there is not always opportunities to access sufficient formal open space within a settlement. In the case of Bonar Bridge, there is a selection of types of open spaces available however there is not a sufficient quantity of them to meet the needs to the community.

Accessibility

The majority of the open spaces within Bonar Bridge can be accessed within reasonable walking distance of all residences. On the outskirts of the settlement there is poor access to amenity greenspace however this may be balanced against the accessibility of the wider countryside from the development for recreational purposes.
