**Quantity**

The provision standard of 40m<sup>2</sup> is only just met in Fort Augustus due to open space provision being dominated by a large area of private ground around Fort Augustus Abbey which is not counted in the audit. Given the importance Fort Augustus has in terms of tourism it would be beneficial to continue to protect and enhance open space provision in the settlement especially that running alongside the canal. There are a number of deficiencies in open space most obviously in outdoor sports facilities and other functional greenspaces.

**Accessibility**

The accessible open spaces in the village are located largely on its periphery, with a green corridor running through the centre of the village alongside the Caledonian Canal. This does not necessarily give good access to open spaces for all residents of the village therefore it is important to look at the linkages between the village and the spaces to ensure that everyone has the opportunity to use the open space.
