## **Profile**

### **Settlement Assessment**

#### Quantity

Open space provision is dominated by outdoor sports facilities within the settlement. There are also limited areas of amenity greenspace and other functional greenspace (cemetery). The provision is mainly located around the centre of the settlement leaving gaps in provision in some areas of the settlement. This can be balanced against the excellent connections to the wider countryside providing opportunities for physical activity and recreation.

### Accessibility

The majority of the dwellings in the settlement can access open space within a reasonable distance using active travel. In the outlying areas there are issues with access to open space however, this can be counter balanced by the good level of access to the outdoors providing opportunities to physical activity and recreation.
