Settlement Assessment

Quantity

There is a significant supply of a range of types of open space in Golspie. There are some types of open space which are not well provided within the settlement, this includes green corridors and other functional greenspace in the form of allotments. The majority of provision is provided through outdoor sports facilities which can act as multifunctional greenspaces.

Accessibility

The majority of dwellings within Golspie can reach a range of open spaces within a comfortable walking distance. There are some areas of the settlement which have limited access to amenity greenspace, this is owing to the more linear nature of Golspie. There is significant recreational access to the rear of the settlement in the form of tracks and trails on Ben Braggie helping to provide additional access to the wider countryside.
