


Quantity

This majority of the provision is through outdoor sports facilities and natural/semi-natural greenspaces. There is no deficiency in amenity greenspace, provision for children and teenagers or public parks and gardens. In time, the completion of the Inshes District Park will lead to the creation of a significant new greenspace for the City of Inverness.

Accessibility

There are areas of the city which do not have sufficient access to certain types of open space and these can be seen on the maps on the pages before. These are largely surrounding the City Centre and on the outskirts of the City.
