

Settlement Assessment

Quantity

The provision per person does not quite meet the standard of $40m^2$ per person but considering the accessibility to the wider countryside this is considered acceptable but diversification of the existing spaces in time may be appropriate. There is a lack of some types of open space within the settlement including natural/semi-natural greenspace and other functional greenspace (inc. allotments). The open space provided as outdoor sports facilities is the most significant provider of open space in the area.

Accessibility

The village forms a horseshoe around the south of Loch Na Ba Buidhe and the majority of open space around the south east edge of the loch. This provides a slight access issue for the built area of the village to the south west of the Loch as it increases travel time to the open spaces, however this is not overly prohibitive and access to all types of open space can be reached by active travel.
