



Settlement Assessment

Quantity

On paper it seems like there maybe an oversupply of open space in Lairg, however if broken down by types of provision there is a deficiency of other functional greenspace and natural greenspace. The majority of open space provision is provided in the form of outdoor sports facilities.

Accessibility

The majority of the open space in Lairg is to the east of Little Loch Shin which provides a mix of amenity greenspace, provision for children and teenagers and outdoor sports facilities. The access to these open spaces to the west of the loch is limited however there is better access at this side of the loch to a public park. While accessibility is generally good on the east of the loch there are areas of the settlement where amenity greenspace is not easily accessible by active travel this includes the north and south of the Lairg.
