


Settlement Assessment

Quantity

The quantity of open space falls just below the standard of 40m² per person, however given the excellent access to the wider countryside this can be mitigated. There is a mix of open other functional greenspace (cemetery), provision for children and teenagers and outdoor sports facilities, however there is a lack of formal open space in the form of allotments. This is something that is understandable given the size of gardens of dwellings within the settlement.

Accessibility

The majority of the settlement can access some form of open space. Due to the way in which the village has developed around Loch Inver, open space is spread unevenly around the settlement and therefore may not be as accessible as at first look. While it would be a challenge to correct this due to the landform it would be appropriate to ensure any active travel linkages between the sites could be improved in time.
