Settlement Assessment

Quantity

The open space provision falls below the 40m² standard against which we are assessing all settlements. The open space available in the village comprises of other functional greenspace and a public park. The public park is flexible and can be used for informal outdoor sports, play and as an amenity greenspace.

Accessibility

As Poolewe is a small settlement access to and between the open spaces is good. There are also significant opportunities to access the wider countryside for recreation. The River Ewe splits the village, however this does not create a significant obstacle to access due to the compact nature of the village and the location of the river crossing.
