

Settlement Assessment

Quantity

The provision standards indicate that there is significant open space per head of population in Tain. However there are deficiencies in allotments. These deficiencies could be addressed through negotiations with developers on the larger housing sites in and around the settlement.

Accessibility

Due to the spread of open space in the town there is good accessibility to most areas of open space from the residential areas. However given that the majority of open spaces are within the town, there is potentially poor accessibility to open space from the residential areas to the west of the A9, however some underpasses are provided.
