Settlement Assessment

Quantity

There is a significant mix of provision of open space right across. Wick with the majority of open space being provided in the form of outdoor sports facilities. There is a number of amenity green spaces south of Wick Bay and a large area of natural/semi-natural greenspace towards the mouth of the river. Wick seems to be under provided for in terms of provision for children and teenagers however the amenity greenspaces and outdoor sports provision are made up of flexible areas which could also be used for informal recreation for children and teenagers.

Accessibility

The majority of residents in Wick can access open space within a reasonable distance of their homes. There is significantly more open space to the south of the river and Wick Bay and with limited access across the river and bay this means that accessibility to open space in the Willowbank, Hillhead and Broadhaven areas of the town can be seen as limited.
