1. Ro-ràdh Tha Bòrd na Gàidhlig a’ cur fàilte ann am prionnsapal, air an iomairt gus sgìrean-sgoile airson Foghlam tro Mheadhan na Gàidhlig (FtG) a stèidheachadh anns na sgoiltean a tha air an liostadh gu h-àrd. Tha am Bòrd ag aithneachadh gu bheil Comhairle na Gàidhealtachd a’ gluasad a dh’ionnsaigh a bhith a’ stèidheachadh sgìrean-sgoile far a bheil solar FtG ann an sgìre na Comhairle. Tha an Stiùireadh Reachdail air Foghlam Gàidhlig agus Plana Nàiseanta na Gàidhlig airson 2018-23 mar bhunait airson freagairt a’ Bhùird dhan cho-chomhairle seo. Tha e mar bhunait dhan Stiùireadh Reachdail, gum bu chòir FtG a leasachadh agus gum bu chòir fàs a thoirt air agus tha barrachd mion-fhiosrachaidh air seo san stiùireadh.	1. Introduction Bòrd na Gàidhlig welcomes in principle, the initiative to establish school catchment areas for Gaelic Medium Education (GME) in the above listed schools. The Bòrd recognises that Highland Council is moving to the establishment of catchment areas where there does exist GME provision in the Council’s area. The Statutory Guidance on Gaelic Education and the National Gaelic Language Plan 2018-23 form the basis for the Bòrd’s response to this consultation. The Statutory Guidance, where there is further detail on the steps involved, has as its basis that GME should develop and grow.
2. Consultation Information The Highland Council say they want to establish catchment areas for the following reasons: The Statutory Guidance on Gaelic Education recommends that Local

Tha an t-Ùghdarras Ionadail a' dèanamh na h-eacarsaich a rèir an dleistanais a bhith a' toirt seachad Luach as Fheàrr ann an lìbhrigeadh sheirbheisean. • Tha an t-Ùghdarras Ionadail air an cleachdadh a chur an sàs de bhith a' toirt seachad còmh-dhail taobh a-staigh astar siubhail reusanta, a thathar a' mìneachadh sa chumantas mar taobh a-staigh 15 mìle bho sgoil a tha a' lìbhrigeadh FtG.	Authorities establish catchment areas for GME. • There is currently a lack of clarity for parents and carers seeking to access GME in the communities served by the GME provision listed. The Local Authority is undertaking the exercise in line with the duty to provide Best Value in service delivery. • The Local Authority has used the practice of providing transport within a reasonable travelling distance, which has generally been understood to mean within 15 miles of a school delivering GME.

Council recommendations GME Provision in Craighill Primary School / Tain 3-18 Campus In principle Bòrd na Gàidhlig supports the establishment of a clear catchment area for the GME provision in Craighill Primary School / Tain 3-18 Campus, both Secondary and Primary provision, as proposed by the Highland Council. • Bòrd na Gàidhlig note that parents have raised concerns that Golspie ASG has not been

Tha sinn a' cur fàilte air a' mholadh gum faigh na teaghlaichean seo taic siubhail gus an cuir iad crìoch air FtG. • Bu chòir do Chomhairle na Gàidhealtachd a bhith a' beachdachadh air a bheil e iomchaidh taic siubhail a thoirt air falbh bho theaghlaichean sam bith a tha a' fuireach taobh a-staigh BSC Ghoillspidh san àm ri teachd. Ged a tha sinn a' tuigsinn gum faodadh ùine siubhail bho chuid de sgìrean taobh a-staigh ASG Ghoillspidh a bhith dùbhlanaich, tha e soilleir gu bheil sgìrean eile ruigsinneach le pàrantan a' taghadh FtG an-dràsta agus roimhe. • Tha sinn a' cur fàilte air a' mholadh ma dh'fhosglas an t-solair FtG aig Drochaid a' Bhannath a-rithist ri linn barrachd iarrtais, gum	included in the catchment area when historically, families from this ASG have previously accessed GME at Craighill Primary School. • We note that the consultation document indicated families are currently accessing GME from Invershin, which is in the Lairg Primary School catchment area and part of Golspie ASG. The proposal that these families will continue to receive transport, until they complete GME, is welcome. • Highland Council should give due consideration on whether it is appropriate to remove transport to GME from any future families living within the Golspie ASG. While we appreciate that travel time from some areas within the Golspie ASG may be prohibitive, other areas are accessible with parents opting for GME currently and in the past. • We welcome the proposal that should the mothballed GME provision at Bonar Bridge re-open due to increased demand, that the GME catchment for Tain would require to be amended, and new GME catchment published for Bonar Bridge Primary School.

4. Stiùireadh Reachdail airson Foghlam Gàidhlig Tha an Stiùireadh Reachdail airson Foghlam Gàidhlig a' moladh gun tèid sgìrean-sgoile a stèidheachadh airson sgoiltean far a bheil Foghlam tro Mheadhan na Gàidhlig (FtG) ri fhaighinn (Earrann 2.53 is 2.54). Sgìrean-sgoile is Stiùireadh airson Àiteachan a Ghleidheadh do Sgoilearan Bu chòir do dh'ùghdarrasan foghlaim sgìrean-sgoile a stèidheachadh airson FtG, agus dh'fhaodadh gum bi iad ag iarraidh beachdachadh air an iarrtas a th' ann airson FtG nuair a tha iad a' stèidheachadh stiùireadh airson nan àiteachan a thèid a ghleidheadh do sgoilearan ann am FtG. A rèir 2.54: Bu chòir do sgìre-sgoile airson sgoil le FtG a bhith na sgìre far a bheil an t-ùghdarras foghlaim den bheachd gu bheil e reusanta do chloinn san sgìre sin, a tha airson a dhol gu FtG, siubhal dhan sgoil, agus bu chòir gum bi cothrom ann pàrantan a thàladh gu bhith cur an cuid chloinne gu FtG.	4. Statutory Guidance on Gaelic Education The Statutory Guidance on Gaelic Education recommends that catchment areas be established for schools where Gaelic-medium education (GME) is provided (Section 2.53 & 2.54). Catchment Areas and Placing Guidelines Education authorities should establish catchment areas for GME provision and may wish to consider demand for GME when setting guidelines for placing pupils in GME provision. 2.54 states: A catchment area of GME provision should be an area in which the education authority thinks it is reasonable for pupils wishing to receive GME provision to travel to school and should have the potential to attract parents to choose GME provision for their children.
