THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council, on 5th June 2025, being satisfied that traffic on certain roads should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public, made the above-named order in terms of Section 14(1)(b) of the Roads Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The order will come into effect on 18th June 2025.

The effect of the Order is to introduce a permanent 20mph speed limit on roads in 127 settlements across the Highland Council area. The Order was previously advertised by Notice in all 5 Highland Editions of the Press and Journal on 6th January 2025, along with being advertised on the Press and Journal Website between 6^{th –} 12th January 2025. The effect of the Order is as described in that Notice.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that a requirement of that Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the Court of Session.
