THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (WHITECHAPEL ROAD, WICK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2025

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as 'The Highland Council (Whitechapel Road, Wick) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) Order 2025' and shall come into effect at 00:01 hrs on 2nd July 2025 and remain in effect for a maximum period of 18 months.
- 2. The reason for making this Order is to ensure the safe passage of vehicles and pedestrians by preventing the obstruction of traffic by parked vehicles.
- 3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-
 - "vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads, whether or not by mechanical power; "Parking Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as "parking attendant" in section 63A of the 1984 Act; "wait" refers to the stopping of a vehicle and it remaining at rest for some time whether or not the driver is still in the vehicle.
- 4. Subject to Article 6 of this Order, no person shall except under the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or Parking Enforcement Officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the length of road specified in the map (TTRO1) to this Order which is identified as being a length of road upon which a "No Waiting at Any Time" restriction applies.
- 5. Subject to Article 6 of this Order, no person shall except under the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or Parking Enforcement Officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle on the length of road specified in the map (TTRO1) to this Order which is identified as being a length of road upon which a "No Loading at Any Time" restriction applies
- 6. Emergency services' vehicles, being used in an emergency for ambulance, coastguard, fire brigade or police purposes, are exempt from the restrictions and prohibitions detailed in this Order.

7. All provisions contained in any Order, Enactment, or others in so far as the same repeat or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and the true intent or meaning hereof shall cease to have effect during the period stated in Article 1 of this Order.
